## PARADE RULES

### BREMENFEST PARADE

AUGUST 18, 2019 - 1:00 p.m. Starting Time

1. Theme for the parade will be **Together We Can:\_\_\_**. It is not mandatory that all floats be built in harmony with the theme, but those that are will be judged accordingly.
2. Line up is at 11:00 a.m. in the Amsterdam Plaza Shopping Center parking lot located on State Route 66 South. Judges will come through the staging area to pre-judge entries. Preliminary judging will be from 11:30 a.m. – 12:30 p.m.
3. To avoid traffic congestion, all rolling units should be in the staging area by 11:00 a.m. Marching units should be in line by 12:45 p.m. The parade begins at 1:00 p.m. All animal units can wait until 12:00 noon to stage.
4. All entries should maintain 50 feet intervals during the parade. Please remember to keep this spacing in order to keep a good flow to the parade.
5. All entries should be decorated. Please no commercial vehicles unless they are of an unusual nature to make our parade more entertaining.
6. For safety reasons, all candy must be hand carried to children along the route.
7. Entries deemed dangerous, and entries dispensing dangerous articles during the parade will be disqualified and dismissed from the parade route. The parade committee can do this at any time, including along the parade route.
8. The parade committee reserves the right to screen entries and deny participation to any entry for noncompliance with the rules or when all available positions are filled.
9. Marching awards will be given out directly following the parade from the headquarters tent. All float and rolling stock awards will be given before the beginning of the parade.
10. Your spot in the parade will be assigned when you arrive. No verification of your entry will be mailed to you.
